

Trike Race Rules & Regulations

The following rules must be observed by all participants of the race without exception.

1. All racing participants must be 18 years of age or older.
2. At no time shall more than one person be involved with the vehicle except in the hand off at the end of a complete lap. Lap size determined by the Trike Race Committee.
3. Each participant is required to wear a crash helmet on their head throughout the entire operation of the vehicle.
4. All riders are required to propel their vehicle from a seated position only using only their feet.
5. No rider or vehicle shall have any assistance outside of their own human operator's power to propel their vehicle. The use of any assistance including but not limited to: Batteries, motors or gears is cause for immediate disqualification.
6. All riders must have a paid sponsor either individual or business.
7. All riders must complete a liability waiver prior to competing in the race.
8. Teams may only ride an approved "Trike" as decided by the trike race committee. Custom or personal trikes must be approved prior to race day. Setting up a date and time for custom or modified trikes is the responsibility of the team choosing to enter a custom or modified vehicle.
9. Have FUN!

Scoring:

All riders/teams will complete the obstacle as described by the Trike Race Committee.

Riders will complete a series of obstacles along the described route, failure to complete the obstacle as explained on race day will result in a 30 second time penalty being assessed to the final time of the team associated with the error/violation.

Participants will receive a timed score based on their ability to complete the course. All team participants times will be calculated including any incurred penalties. Teams with the lowest and best scores will advance to the Championship Races for a chance at the Grand Prix Trophy

Timed scores are recorded by multiple time keepers to ensure accuracy.

All decisions by the Trike Race Committee are final.
